The board discussed a potential problem facing the extended Rainbow Lake community, that of dead and dying ash trees. An invasive insect, the emerald ash borer, has decimated all ash trees in the northeast, leaving potentially hazardous trees all around the neighborhood. Those trees situated near power lines are especially problematic. While the town and Eversource are aware of the problem neither has been able to effectively cope with the scale. The RLA recommends that homeowners survey their property and contact the Town (Tree Warden) or Eversource if they think they have a tree that needs to be taken down.
