In its regularly scheduled January Meeting:

•Suction Dredging:

In light of the fact the completed dredging at the Crescent Rd cove did not fill the bag, the Board agreed to ask the dredgers if they could use that bag again for the dredging planned for Crescent Beach. Doug will make contact.

• Membership:

We are coming off one of our best membership drives in many years, maybe ever. To keep the momentum going the welcoming committee will restart the visits with new neighbors this spring. There may be as many as 25 potential visits to raise support for the lake. The Board has also decided to raise dues for the first time in several years. Starting after April first the new tiers will be:

Lake Front; \$375 Lake View: \$350 General: \$185 Dues paid before April 1st 2021 will be at the old rates

• Work Projects:

There are no work projects formally in the pipeline right now, but the Board is looking at several projects including community docks and more boat racks.

• Boat Stickers:

In a slight change the Board has decided to allot one boat sticker per membership as opposed to the two previously allotted. A second sticker may be purchased for an additional \$15. The Board hopes this change will eliminate some superfluous boats at the beaches

• Phoslock: The Board will explore the use of a phosphorous binding agent to reduce the amount of herbicide used to control algae blooms.
